The Mercury Phoenix Trust


The Mercury Phoenix Trust was set up as a UK registered charity in 1992 by Queen's manager, Jim Beach, and band members Brian May and Roger Taylor in memory of rock band Queen's iconic lead singer Freddie Mercury who died in 1991 from AIDS. With the objective *"to use Freddie's memory, his charisma and drive to eradicate this disease"*, the Mercury Phoenix Trust has funded over 1000 projects in 56 countries in the global battle against HIV / AIDS.



Fighting HIV / AIDS

It is sometimes perceived that HIV / AIDS is no longer a major issue and some people tend to believe that it is now "curable" or that it "doesn't really kill anyone" any more and only affects some minorities.

Trend of new HIV infections



- Approximately 36.9 million people worldwide were living with HIV / AIDS in 2017.
- Of these, **1.8 million** were **children** under 15 years.
- 1.8 million people were newly infected with HIV in 2017, with around 7'000 young women aged 15–24 years becoming infected with HIV every week.
- **15 million** people had **no access** to antiretroviral therapy in 2017.
- 940'000 people (more than 2'500 a day) died from AIDS-related illnesses in

2017, bringing the total number of people who have died from AIDS-related illnesses since the start of the epidemic to **35.4 million**. (Source: UNAIDS, Global HIV & AIDS statistics - 2018 fact sheet)
